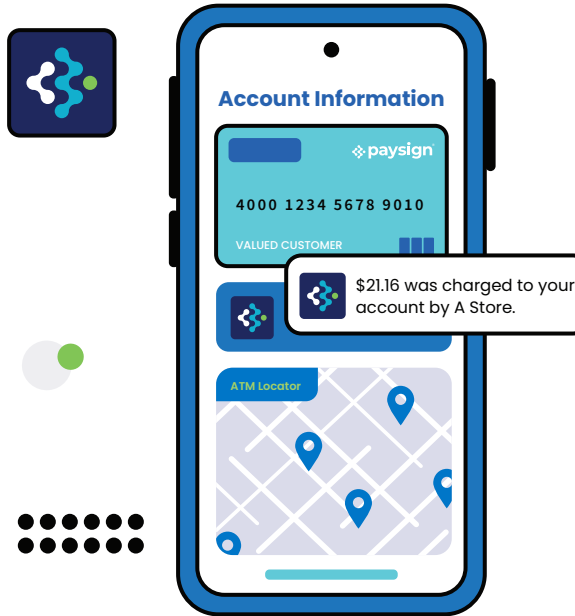

The Paysign® mobile app allows you to keep track of your spending on the go. Check your balance, view recent transactions, set up alerts,* find ATMs, and more.

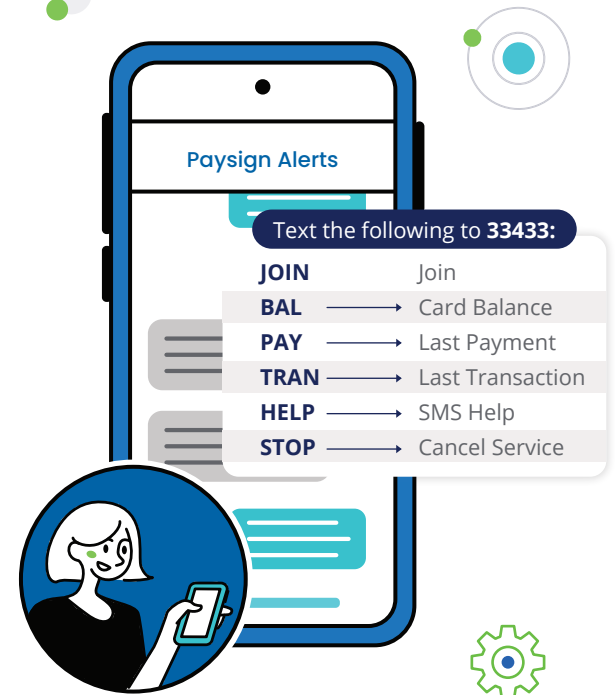

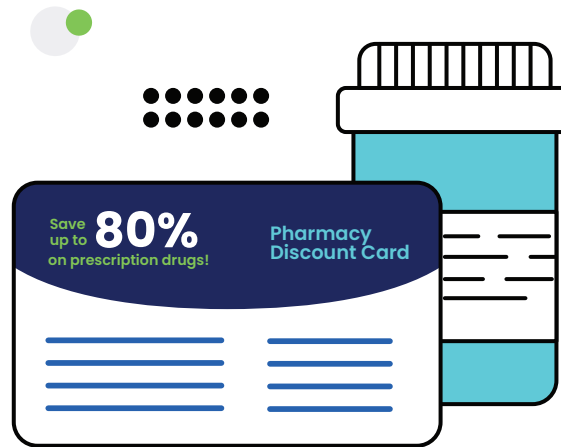

Pharmacy Discount Card FAQ

What is a pharmacy discount card?

A pharmacy discount card can be used instead of insurance and helps you save up to 80% on prescription drugs at most U.S. pharmacies.

Why do I need a pharmacy discount card?

Prescription drug prices are unregulated and can vary greatly from different pharmacies. Insurance isn't helping as much as it used to and in the past decade, patients have become responsible for 25-80% more of a prescription's cost.

How do I use a pharmacy discount card?

Simply present your pharmacy discount card when picking up your prescription. The pharmacist will enter the numbers on the card into their system to find the discount.

Can I use a pharmacy discount card if I have insurance or Medicare?

Yes, you can use the pharmacy discount card whether or not you have insurance or Medicare. Many insurance plans have high deductibles or limited formularies that don't cover the drugs you need. When the pharmacy discount card offers a better prescription price, use it instead of insurance.

Do I need a prescription to use a pharmacy discount card?

Yes, you will need a valid prescription from a U.S.-based physician in order to use the pharmacy discount card.
